

# BUCKY O'NEILL MILITARY RIFLE COMPETITION

## Rifle Requirements and Course of Fire

### **ALL ROUNDS MUST BE LEAD BULLETS, NO JACKETED AMMUNITION.**

AUTHORIZED FIREARMS MUST BE MILITARY CARTRIDGE STANDARD ISSUE SINGLE SHOT, AND BOLT ACTION RIFLES AND CARBINES OR REPLICAS OF THOSE USED BY THE UNITED STATES MILITARY OR FOREIGN MILITARY UNITS BETWEEN 1865 AND 1912, USING THE AMMUNITION SPECIFIC TO THE ORIGINAL DESIGN OF THE RIFLES AND CARBINES (NO RECHAMBERS TO ROUNDS AFTER 1912). EXAMPLES: SPENCER'S, 1865-1899 SPRINGFIELD'S (TRAPDOORS), 1871 REMINGTON'S, 1865-1871 SHARPS MILITARY RIFLES AND CARBINES. 1893-1899, Krag's, 1891-1909 Mauser's (**No K- 98 Mauser's**), 1903 SPRINGFIELD'S (**NO 1903A3's**) or OTHER MILITARY MOSIN-NAGANT 1891 AND 07 CARBINES (**NO MOSIN NAGANT 91/30's**) RIFLES AND CARBINES earlier than 1912.

SHOOTERS MUST USE BARREL MOUNTED MILSPEC (Military Specified) sights APPROPRIATE FOR THEIR RIFLE OR CARBINE. ISSUE PEEP TYPE SIGHTS ARE ALLOWED TO BE USED. ALL RIFLES AND CARBINES MUST BE IN SAFE SERVICEABLE CONDITION.

**NO EXCEPTIONS.**

## There will be a Single shot Rifle and a Bolt Action Category

**COURSE OF FIRE SINGLESHOT CATEGORY:** SHOOTER TO START WITH OPEN EMPTY CHAMBER WITH HAMMER AT HALF OR FULL COCK. FIRST AND ADDITIONAL ROUNDS MAY BE HELD IN HAND.

**BOLT ACTION CATEGORY: CAN HAVE 5 ROUNDS LOADED IN THE MAGAZINE WITH THE BOLT OPEN AND AN EMPTY CHAMBER,** ALL ADDITIONAL ROUNDS TO BE LOADED INDIVIDUALLY ON THE CLOCK. SPENCERS ARE REPEATING RIFLES, AS ARE ANY OTHER RIFLES OR CARBINES HOLDING ROUNDS IN A TUBE, BOX OR DETACHABLE MAGAZINE AND CAN BE SHOT IN THE BOLT ACTION CATEGORY ONLY AND MAY HAVE 5 ROUNDS LOADED IN THE MAGAZINE WITH THE CHAMBER OPEN AND EMPTY, ADDITIONAL ROUNDS MUST BE LOADED INDIVIDUALLY (**Stripper Clips Allowed**) ON THE CLOCK.

**THE CLOCK WILL START ON THE RO'S SIGNAL.**

**ALL RIFLES AND CARBINES MUST BE AT MILITARY PORT ARMS. MAGAZINES TO BE LOADED AT POSITION ONE TO START.** SHOOTER WILL START STANDING AT POSITION ONE, SHOOTER WILL NOTIFY RO WHEN READY. ON SIGNAL SHOOTER WILL FIRE **5 ROUNDS** AT THE 100 YD TARGET IN THE **OFFHAND (STANDING) POSITION. ON COMPLETION OF THE STRING WITH BREECH OPEN AND EMPTY.** SHOOTER WILL MOVE TO POSITION TWO AND FIRE **5 ROUNDS** AT THE 200 YD TARGET IN **THE KNEELING POSITION. ON COMPLETION OF THE STRING WITH BREECH OPEN AND EMPTY.** SHOOTER WILL MOVE TO POSITION THREE AND FIRE **5 ROUNDS** AT THE 300 YD TARGET IN THE **SITTING OR PRONE** POSITION. SHOOTER WILL FIRE A TOTAL OF 15 RDS AND MAKE THE RIFLE SAFE!

ROUNDS MUST COME FROM THE SHOOTER VIA UNIFORM POCKETS, MILITARY CARTRIDGE BELTS (PRAIRIE, CAVALRY OR MILLS ETC.), HAZEN BELT SLIDES, MILITARY AMMUNITION BOXES (Mc KEEVER, DYRE, ETC.), BUT **NOT FROM ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL OR FROM ANY BODY ORIFICES.**

**NO ARTIFICIAL RESTS (STICKS, BALES, ETC) ALLOWED.**

**NO MOVEMENT WILL BE DONE UNTIL THE BREECH IS OPEN AND EMPTY**
