LONG RANGE BOLT ACTION

Bolt Action Course of fire:

Can have Five (5) rounds Loaded in the magazine with the bolt open and an empty chamber.

Clock will Start on the RO's signal.

All rifles and carbines must be at military port arms to start. Magazines to be loaded at position one (1) to start. Shooter will start standing at Position one (1) and will notify the RO when ready.

Shooter will alternate between two (2) targets for five (5) rounds beginning on the left target.

Additional round to be loaded on the clock: may come from the body, pockets, loading blocks, belts, boxes and blankets etc.

Additional rounds cannot come from another individual or ANY bodily orifice!

No artificial rests (sticks, bales, etc.) are allowed. Use of an appropriate sling is permitted.

No movement will be made until the breech is open and empty

Rifle requirements

All ammunition to be lead bullets, No jacketed rounds!

Authorized firearms must be military cartridge standard issue single shot, bolt action rifles, carbines or replicas of those used by the United States Military or foreign military units before the end of WW2

Shooters must use barrel mounted milspec (Military Specifications) sights Appropriate for the rifle or carbine. Issue peep type sights are allowed to be used. All rifles and carbines must be in safe serviceable condition. **No Exceptions!**
