SERGEANT YORK

Course of fire:

Rifle with five (5) rounds loaded in the magazine with the bolt open and an empty chamber.

Pistol with six (6) rounds in magazine and holstered.

Clock will Start on the RO's signal.

All rifles and carbines must be held at military port arms to start. Magazines to be loaded, shooters to notify RO when ready.

With the rifle the shooter will alternate between two (2) targets for five (5) rounds beginning on the left target.

Then with the pistol the shooter will engage the six (6) pistol targets, one round each, in a sweep starting on the far pistol target and ending on the closest pistol target.

No artificial rests (sticks, bales, etc.) allowed. Use of an appropriate sling is permitted.

Firearm requirements

All ammunition to be lead bullets, No jacketed rounds!

Authorized firearms must be military cartridge standard issue bolt action rifles, carbines or replicas of those used by the United States Military or foreign military units before the end of WW2

Shooters must use barrel mounted milspec (Military Specified) sights appropriate for the rifle or carbine. Issue peep type sights are allowed to be used. All rifles and carbines must be in safe serviceable condition. **No Exceptions!**

Pistol must be SASS legal 1911 pistol
